## Gulp! A Second Chance

**Jonah 2:10 (NIV)** And the LORD commanded the fish, and it vomited Jonah onto dry land.

**Jonah 3:1 (NIV)** Then the word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time:

**Jonah 3:2 (NIV)** "Go to the great city of Nineveh and proclaim to it the message I give you."

**Jonah 3:3-4 (NIV)** Jonah obeyed the word of the LORD and went to Nineveh. Now Nineveh was a very important city—a visit required three days. On the first day, Jonah started into the city. He proclaimed: "Forty more days and Nineveh will be overturned."

**Jonah 3:5-9 (NIV)** The Ninevites believed God. They declared a fast, and all of them, from the greatest to the least, put on sackcloth. When the news reached the king of Nineveh, he rose from his throne, took off his royal robes, covered himself with sackcloth and sat down in the dust. Then he issued a proclamation in Nineveh: "By the decree of the king and his nobles: Do not let any man or beast, herd or flock, taste anything; do not let them eat or drink. But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth. Let everyone call urgently on God. Let them give up their evil ways and their violence. Who knows? God may yet relent and with compassion turn from his fierce anger so that we will not perish."

**Psalms 32:3-5 (NLT)** When I refused to confess my sin, my body wasted away, and I groaned all day long. Day and night your hand of discipline was heavy on me. My strength evaporated like water in the summer heat. Finally, I confessed all my sins to you and stopped trying to hide my guilt. I said to myself, "I will confess my rebellion to the LORD." And you forgave me! All my guilt is gone.

**Psalms 51:17 (NLT)** The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God.

**Matthew 3:8 (NLT)** Prove by the way you live that you have repented of your sins and turned to God.

But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Advocate won't come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment."
